


Curriculum Policy

The curriculum for each Male College International (MCI) child is linked directly to the curriculum for a Male College in the UK (MCUK), which being designed to take account of the local culture. Before MCUK and the associated Primary school, The Dromedary (TDM), the intended curriculum for the 3-18 child is based on the English Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1-4 of the National Curriculum for England and Wales. GCSE examinations are taken at the end of Key Stage 4 and choice for the A Level includes the IB Diploma Programme offered in the Sixth Form. Whilst the local curriculum for the child follows the national curriculum for the MCUK and TDM, it should be noted that it is a broad and balanced education which includes the full IB curriculum for the Primary Years Group of the Middle Years and Diploma Programme. The choice for the child will be based on the child's interests and needs.
